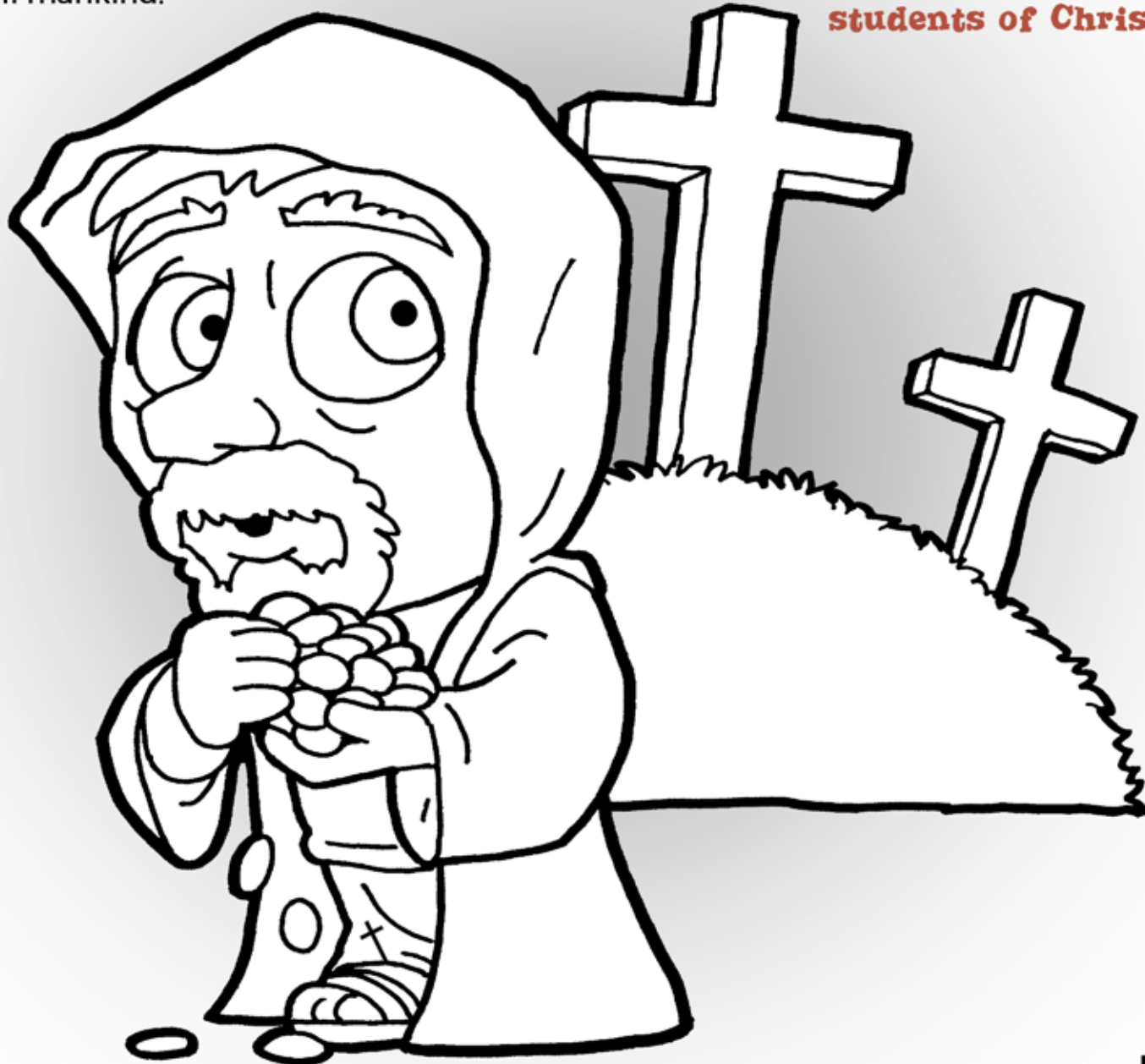
Means :
