She knew she needed a Savior.




Simon the Pharisee





Jesus looked at Mary with compassion in His heart and said, "Your sins have been forgiven."


Mary knew she was a sinner and needed forgiveness from the One true and living God of the Bible, The Lord Jesus Christ.


